Organoleptic characteristics: dry white wine - light golden color, with amber nuances. The intense aroma is dominated by flowers and exotic fruits. The full, opulent taste is complex, with notes of almond and vanilla, followed by a long aftertaste, harmoniously

dominated by nuances of maturation.

Aged for 6 months in French oak barriques.

The recommended temperature for consumption is +10/+12 °C Pairings: fresh cheeses, vegetable salad, turbot fillet au gratin with

black rice.
